Dear Clerk

In response to Government requirements to digitise and adopt electronic rather than paper driven processes, we have reviewed our business processes with regards to processing planning applications to determine where we can become more efficient, particularly with regards to printing and postage. Before we roll this out to all town and parish councils in Central Bedfordshire, we would appreciate your feedback on the new system to help us make the change as smooth as possible.

From this date forward, on receipt of a planning application we will send you a full set of plans and a copy of the planning application form only. All supporting documents, that have previously been printed and posted to you, will only be available on our website and we will email a link to the supporting documentation to you. We are working with IT to minimise the time it takes for supporting documents to load.

If the applicant is prepared to supply all documentation in paper form we will of course post this onto you.

Feedback on any difficulties you experience implementing this new process would be very helpful so that we can address these issues before it is rolled out to all town and parish councils in 6 weeks.
