Reason for the proposal: The proposed Order is considered necessary on the grounds of promoting road safety and improving the environment of the area. The proposed restriction would prohibit HGVs over 7.5 tonnes from using Orchard Road, Beeston as a through route. The proposal should significantly reduce the number of large vehicles making a potentially hazardous right turn across the A1 to access the southbound carriageway.

### Effect of the Order:

### To introduce a 7.5 tonnes HGV Weight Restriction on the following length of road:-

Orchard Road, Beeston, Sandy for its full length from its junction with A1 High Road to its junction with The Green.

<u>Exemptions</u>: The proposed Order will include exemptions to allow heavy goods vehicles over 7.5 tonnes to enter the restricted road for access and delivery requirements. There will also be exemptions for emergency vehicles, for certain other essential purposes.

CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Bedfordshire in accordance with paragraph 20 of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the xxth day of (month) 201\* and may be cited as
   "Central Bedfordshire Council (Orchard Road, Beeston Sandy) (Weight Restriction) Order 201\*
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, drive or cause to be driven any heavy commercial goods vehicle the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes on the lengths of road described in the Schedule to this Order (hereinafter referred to as "the said lengths of road").
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from driving any vehicle on the said lengths of road if the vehicle is being used:-
  - (a) for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (b) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to the said lengths of road;
  - (c) in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic in the said lengths of road;
  - in connection with the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road;
  - (e) in connection with the laying erection alteration or repair in or adjacent to the said lengths of road of any sewer or any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water electricity or telecommunications;

	(f)	for agricultural purposes in connection with land within the area defined in the Schedule
		to this Order;
	(g)	for purposes of access for unloading and loading and garaging of vehicles;
	(h)	for public service vehicle purposes;
	(i)	in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

Orchard Road, Beeston, Sandy for its full length from its junction with A1 High Road to its junction with The Green.



### Statement of Reasons


The proposed Order is considered necessary on the grounds of promoting road safety and improving the environment of the area. The proposed restriction would prohibit HGVs over 7.5 tonnes from using Orchard Road, Beeston as a through route. HGVs use this road when travelling to and from the timber supplier that is located at the southern end of The Green, Beeston.

The proposal should significantly reduce the number of large vehicles making a potentially hazardous right turn across the A1 to access the southbound carriageway. The alternative route for vehicles affected by the prohibition will be via The Green and A1 London Road. Those vehicles wishing to proceed south on the A1 would be required to circumnavigate the A1/A603 Sandy roundabout.

The proposed Order will include exemptions to allow heavy goods vehicles over 7.5 tonnes to enter the restricted road for access and delivery requirements. There will also be exemptions for emergency vehicles and for certain other essential purposes.

The proposed restriction would only prohibit goods vehicles over 7.5 tonnes, so other vehicles over this weight, such as buses, would not be affected.
